Alvaro met Adi Azahar Jonsson in a local show in their teens and eventually ended up in the same high school where they met Axel martinsson. There they found a mutual musical connection and began jamming together. With influences in pop, melodic rock, movie soundtracks and world music they formed Reedon Green.

Alvaro on the electric guitar and vocals, Adi switching between the acoustic/electric guitar and bass, Axel on the vocals and bass and teaming up with Alvaros brother John on the drums was a no brainer. Over the next few years after high school they wrote and recorded songs and played multiple shows in Sweden and also did a small tour of Rio De Janeiro.

In 2017 they took a hiatus to pursue their personal endeavors. Two years later they re-joined and with new energy and inspiration they began writing what would become their upcoming album "this is dark pop".
